Bills of sale are essential to prove a cash sale took place, and they protect both the buyer and seller in the event of a dispute. Shop Around Ask for lease quotes from multiple companies to get a feel for the market in your area. If applicable, this should be transferred when completing the sale. Financing is commonly handled separately through a bank. Most states require a completed vehicle bill of sale to register a motor vehicle at the DMV, and many recommend using a bill of sale if you are buying or selling any item over \$500. Some states have specific requirements as to what must appear on a bill of sale form for it to be accepted. The document is evidence of an agreement between the two parties that a sale has taken place between them. You should include one with your bill of sale if the transfer requires the buyer to take out a loan instead of paying in full. Using a bill of sale protects the buyer and the seller from future legal disputes over the item's condition or ownership. This way you'll be sure that everything will run smoothly and there won't be any unexpected issues down the road. This tax varies by state, and a bill of sale helps determine how much you need to pay. Remember to check individual state requirements before creating your form, as some states have different requirements for certain items. A bill of sale document lines out the details of a transaction between a buyer and seller of the vehicle. Be careful as you fill it out, as both parties' handwriting must be legible for the bill of sale to be valid. At this stage, both parties agree on a payment method and any special conditions of the sale, such as a warranty or financing. It is a legally binding document that is commonly used when the former owner transfers possession of the goods to a new owner. The seller's bill of sale form will show the date the vehicle was sold and the buying party's information. If you've bought a vehicle, you'll need to register it at the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) and pay sales tax. Warranty Provision – A written guarantee that the seller will repair or replace the item if there are any defects over a specified period of time. Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) – A unique identification code for a motor vehicle that you must include in a car bill of sale. If a dispute arises regarding the details or conditions of the transaction, the form can be used as evidence that the transaction took place. Just like any other legal document, double check and understand all of the parts before signing. For example, you cannot legally prove that an item was sold without a bill of sale to record the transaction. If you understand the pros and cons and do your research, however, leasing a car can be a smart financial move that gets you the vehicle you need. Verify the VIN on the title to make sure it matches the actual VIN and that there are no liens. Legal Considerations A bill of sale represents a record of a sold vehicle. Most leases last between two and four years, with longer leases generally have lower monthly payments. If the bill of sale does not have a warranty, the item is sold "as-is." Therefore, the buyer must check the item thoroughly and ask any questions before the sale is completed and the form is signed. You should also be on the look-out for add-ons such as premium maintenance packages, fancy car interior décor, additional insurance policies or pricey alarm systems that may not be worth the cost to you. Not all states require a bill of sale to be notarized. If you don't include a warranty provision in your bill of sale, the item is sold "as-is." Certificate of Title – Separate paperwork that states who the legal owner of an item is.
